



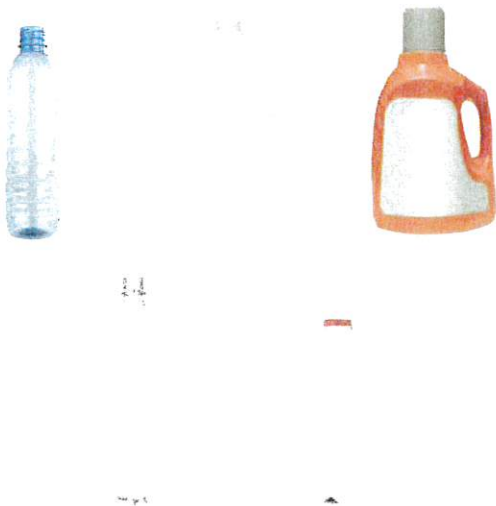
IMPORTANT NOTICE

Due to changing market conditions, we will need to make some changes to what plastics can be put in the recycling containers. These changes are necessary because China has banned specific items from entering their country and there are no other marketing opportunities for these plastics domestically. We apologize for these changes but we simply have no alternatives at this point.

- Effective immediately the only plastic that we can allow in the recycling program are bottles marked with the recycling symbol of #1 PET or #2 HDPE. The definition of a bottle is the opening must be smaller than the base and it must not exceed more than 2 gallons in capacity. Even though the deli trays and clam shell containers are marked as a #1 PET it is a different grade/type of PET than the bottles and unfortunately, we cannot accept them either at this time.
- No plastic film of any kind (this would include grocery bags, trash bags, shrink wrap, bubble wrap etc.)
- No plastic that is marked with #3 thru #7 recycling symbol
